By this point users have created their accounts and are ready to work on their portfolios. Clicking on Upload Portfolio we move to a new page.

- Portfolio Albums can include images, videos or music. Users can create an unlimited number of albums for/from various projects or to highlight the many talents they have (one can be a musician, a dancer and a singer at the same time). When media are uploaded, images go automatically into their perspective folders: pictures to Images, videos to Videos and music files to Song/Music. By creating albums, users move a copy of the file to the new album. It also works the other way around, when users create an album and upload media into it, copies of those files are "filed" too. It may sound redundant, but it helps to avoid deleting media by mistake.
- Our Local Menu won't fully fit so I highlighted the most important one (Create New Portfolio Album) and the "3-dot" Menu will house additional choices. Click on it or see the next wireframe with the menu open.
- The "3-dot" Menu items are not as crucial since users can edit, upload and delete from the submenu 3 that is part of the portfolio, or they can just scroll to the last item 4 (Add picture/video/music) and use it to upload more media. They can also use the Footer navigation.
- Sticky Footer Menu: for users' convenience, the regular footer will be replaced by a menu with four helpful icons to Edit, Upload, Share and Delete media.

All uploading and editing is saved automatically so users can freely move/browse around.
