Create Your Call for Artists is the page where users compose their calls/posts. It consists of two steps: ONE—write a description, TWO—upload media to help explain the project and attract best artists.

- **Description:** on this page, users fill out the form and add a short description of the project.
- Upload Media: images, videos, music files—most formats acceptable with size restrictions.
- Collaborators: users can add other project collaborators and let them be part of the conversation. Artists who may be interested in responding will get a better idea who else they'll be working with.
- Add Another Artist: users might be looking for more than just one artist from one category.
 Users can add another call within the same project and select different talents they're looking for.
- "3-dot" button: will again house choices that are not so crucial. You can see the menu fully open by clicking on it or in the next wireframe.
 - "3-dot" button: with not so crucial choices: users may want to Remove (but keep for later) or Delete the call/post when they are done.
 Users can also Create a New Call right there, without clicking on Collaborate first.

Just in case users would like to check other Artists' portfolios and search for a talent that way,

- they can click on Browse Artists' Profiles.

 Add Another Artist: same as the button at the top, repeated for convenience.
- Save as Draft: users may not be able to finish the calls right away so there is an option to save them as drafts.
- Post Your Call: this is a very exciting moment when users filled out their forms, wrote descriptions, uploaded media to accompany the calls and are ready to hit Post Your Call. It's a nerve wracking moment wondering if everything is correct and sounds okay. But there is no need to worry, users can double-check their posts live by clicking on View Your Post and if any revisions are necessary, they can go back, edit the call and post again. Or, if the revisions take a long time, they can go back and remove (temporarily) the call.
- Footer Menu: just a slight change, the Share icon was replaced with Upload, which is more appropriate and convenient for this page.
